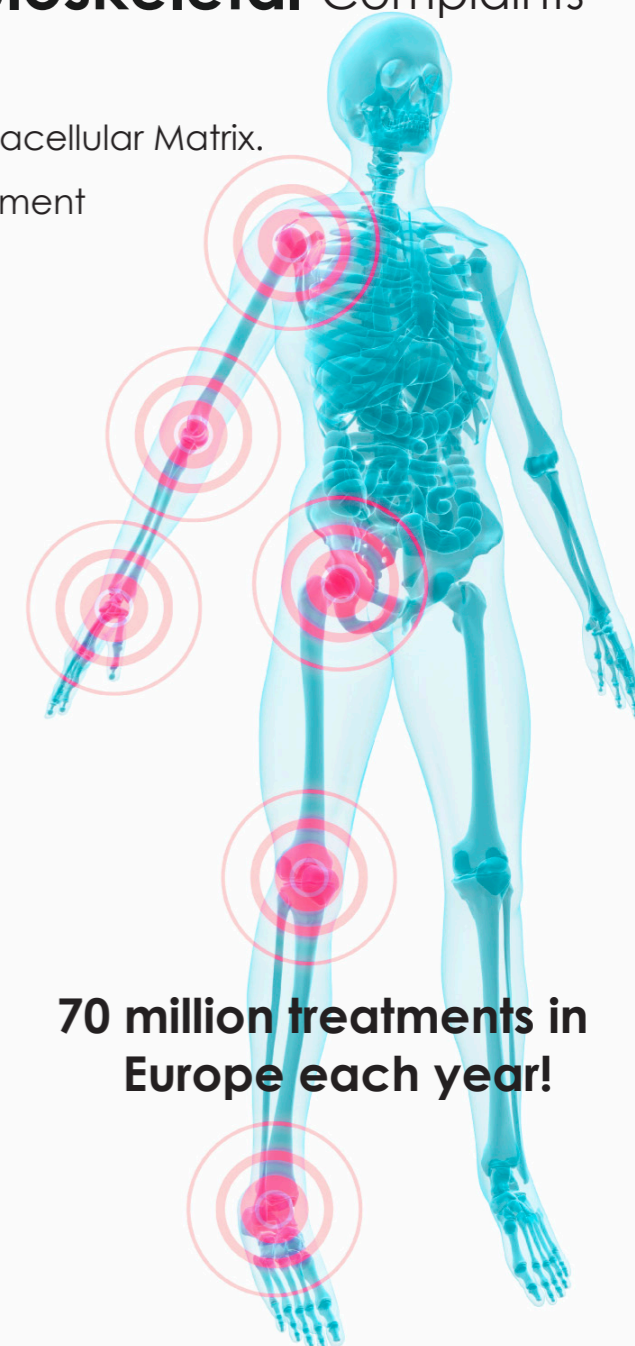

Frequently asked questions

1. What is biomesotherapy/biopuncture?

Biopuncture is a bioregulatory therapeutic method in which, after oral stimulation with antihomotoxic medicine, saline solution is injected into tissue-related bodily zones or points on the basis of clinical and functional diagnosis.

2. What is the difference between biopuncture and other saline injection therapy?

Biopuncture uses carefully selected antihomotoxic remedies in addition to saline injections. The primary role of these remedies is to stimulate the extra cellular matrix for acceleration to the immune system response ("turbo effect").

3. Does it take long?

Biopuncture does not take long at all – after an initial consultation up to 6 - 10 patients per hour may be treated by a naturopath or acupuncturist for follow up treatments of a particular complaint.

4. Is biomesotherapy/biopuncture only for pain?

No! Biopuncture is about activating the extracellular matrix – so it can be used for many other complaints. It is traditionally used to activate detoxification and activation of particular organs and cells. This initial training is focused on musculoskeletal issues.

Practical Biomesotherapy Workshop

An informative, thorough and practical session where participants will cover:

Examination of the Musculoskeletal system for the accurate location of injection sites.

- The Principles of Neural therapy. This therapy has been used for the treatment of pain and overcoming autonomic blocks to healing for a variety of ailments. It has been used for many decades in Europe with sometimes startling results.
- Common patterns of musculoskeletal injury – important ligaments and soft tissue points for treatment.

Finding bony point markers for significant ligaments for biomesotherapy treatment of neck and headache, thoracic and low back pain, knee, hip, ankle, shoulder, elbow and hand.

Protocols and Theory

Participants will be lead through pathologies of the Musculoskeletal system according to Homotoxicology. Protocols will be covered for the Musculoskeletal system which incorporates Homotoxicology, Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine into the Biomesotherapy protocol. Associations of organ health to joint and tissue integrity will be covered. Point identification location will also be covered during this theory course.

COURSE COMPONENTS

Infection control*

Infection control techniques are important for all practitioners, especially those who do not use syringes as part of their clinical practice. There are 2 components to the infection control section of training.

1. All participants must provide evidence of completion of Infection Control HLTIN504B (or equivalent) prior to registration. Registered practitioners who have previously completed infection control training (eg: nurses, acupuncturists) may apply for recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) by submitting relevant documentation.

2. The "in-house" infection control component, offered via study, is necessary for all practitioners who attend Biomesotherapy training. Relevant documentation is provided at registration for completion and submission prior to the practical component.*

HLTIN 504B Infection Control

For those who need to complete the infection control module a course via correspondence is offered through The South Australian College of Natural and Traditional Medicine. The cost is \$340 with enrollment. The course is home study and can be completed in 2-3 weeks. Contact (08) 8371 3055.

***Please note that the submission deadline for this element is 2 weeks prior to the course. Also note that failure to provide evidence of the successful completion of both Infection Control elements (AAOH in house component & HLTIN504B) at least two weeks prior to the course will be seen as not having complied with the basic requirements for seminar participation.**
